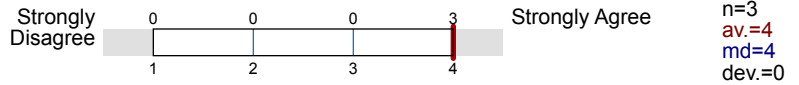

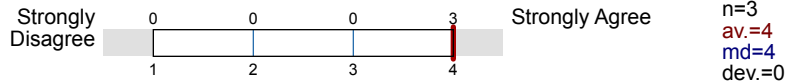

- The instructor made sure to allow time for questions as well as prepared activities that would engage each student through different forms of relaying the material; visually, reading, etc.

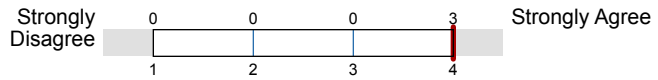

2.5) The instructor(s) made it clear that they could be flexible in accommodating student needs (consider, for example, circumstances that arise unexpectedly, including health and personal issues).

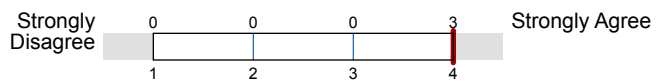

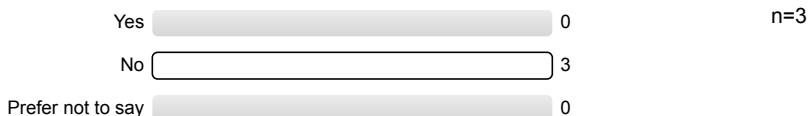
- Because of the format and enjoyment I have had for the class, I would love to take another class with Dr. deGuzman again! His love for history really shines through, and he is able to bring together many

underlying themes to the surface even though we focused on events in LA. The sense of humor he has with the class is what really made the class so fun and that much more enjoyable.

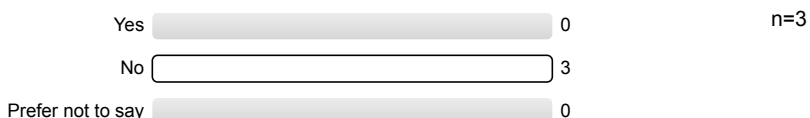
- I really enjoyed the structure and format of this course.
